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Ozaukee County June Home Sales Report Shows Big Increase

Cedarburg, WI—Data market and sales information for Ozaukee County shows the number of single-family, condominium and townhome properties that closed in June totaled 180, compared to 113 for last month, an increase of 59 percent. There were an additional 64 sales pending in Ozaukee County. Cities with the most sales included Mequon/Thiensville with 66, Grafton with 40 and Cedarburg with 36.

With the increase in closed and pending sales, the number of active listings is down 18 percent to 523 from 635 in May and that includes a 20 percent increase in new listings at 196 versus 163 in June 2015.

“It continues to be a strong market” said Mike Didier, 2015/2016 president of Ozaukee REALTORS® Association. “Although we are seeing a slowdown that we didn’t really see last summer, it’s still a strong seller’s market and a great time to list your home.”
